Subject: Relationships between Meibomian Gland Loss and Age, Sex and Dry Eye

Meibomian Gland Dysfunction (MGD) is likely the major cause of abnormal lipid layer and consequently of evaporative dry eye. Meibomian Gland Dysfunction is responsible for approximately two third of the diseases of the dry eye. The strength of association between dry eye status and outcome of Meibography differed between studies. Many studies show that older patients and women are more likely to suffer from dry eye which is related to MGD.

This study evaluated the relationship between Meibomian Gland Loss (MGL) and age, sex and dry eye. Dry eye status and MGL was evaluated in 112 randomly selected subjects (66 women, Mean age-62.8 yrs.). Out of the 112 subjects, 42 subjects were not having a dry eye condition. Meibography of lower lid was performed by using Cobra camera and images analyzed with digital grading tool (Pheonix, bon Optic).

Meibomian gland loss was significantly larger in the dry eye group, while there was no significant difference between MGL scores of men and women. It was almost equal in both the sex which disproves the previous studies. Also, it was seen more for the older people. The relationship between Ocular Surface Disease Index and MGL was stronger in a cohort for dry eye patients rather than non-dry eye patients.
